

## Scenarios



#### Translate the whole site

You need to translate your new website quickly and accurately, including config and interface texts



#### Add a new language

You'd like to offer your website in an additional language without creating significantly more work




#### Ongoing content updates

Content updates on the primary
language site create additional
translation work to ensure that the
other language sites are updated in
a timely manner


# Challenges

- Complex workflow: Translation processes, tracking changes, and coordinating with translators can be a complex process
- Configuration and Ul translation: Translating non-content elements like field labels and interface text adds considerable effort and are sometimes ignored early in the project
- Scalability: As websites grow, managing translations for multiple pages and languages becomes difficult to scale efficiently
- High-cost: Engaging human translators for all content and interface elements can be expensive




### What we want

- **Fast Translations**: Save time and launch your website on schedule by reducing the required manual work.
- Simple Content Updates: Updates in one language can be automatically translated and ready for you in every other language as well.

- No Content Left Behind: Ensure that alt text, menu items, labels, and interface texts are included








